Important Mercury Switch Program Update

PENNSYLVANIA APPROVED TO PARTICIPATE IN NATIONAL PROGRAM; INCENTIVE NOW \$1 PER SWITCH

The Pennsylvania Voluntary Mercury Switch Removal Program will now completely operate through the national program established last year. For the past two years, PARTS administered the program which was funded through a grant from the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) that expired on September 30. Any shipments of switches made on or before September 30 will receive the \$2 per switch incentive. Any switches shipped after October 1 will be reimbursed through the national program at \$1per switch. PARTS will no longer be administering this program nor will we be issuing the reimbursement checks. The collection and recycling of automotive mercury switches under the national program is handled by the End of Life Vehicles Solutions Corporation (ELVS). Incentive checks are paid between 45-60 days following the month the bucket was sent in. Are You Hauling Vehicles Between States?

MCS-90 ENDORSEMENT IS REQUIRED UNDER CERTAIN CONDITIONS

Pennsylvania State Police are stepping up enforcement on interstate hauling of vehicles containing greater than seventeen (17) ounces of fuel. If you haul vehicles from one state to another, you should obtain a federal DOT number (if you don't already have one) **and then** contact your insurance carrier to obtain your MCS-90 endorsement. The MCS-90 is an endorsement on your liability insurance policy which is required by the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations.
