ATTEMPT TO STOP INTERSTATE 80 TOLLS IS BLOCKED

An effort by two Pennsylvania Congressmen to block tolls on Interstate 80 hit a roadblock in Congress. An amendment to a transportation funding bill was proposed by Rep. John Peterson, (R-Pleasantville), and Rep. Phil English, (R-Erie), was stripped out of bill before it could be considered by the House-Senate subcommittee reviewing the bill. In a prepared statement, Rep. Peterson said, "Tolling I-80 is akin to a 'closed for business' sign in Pennsylvania. As bad as these economic implications are, what may be worse about this scheme is doubling the size and scope of the most scandal-ridden, politically polluted and overall wasteful state agency — the Turnpike Commission."
