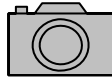
### **MERCURY RULE IMPOSES NEW REQUIREMENTS ON STEELMAKERS**

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has issued new air emission standards aimed at reducing mercury releases from steel manufacturers using electric arc furnaces. The EPA rule requires steel making facilities to buy vehicle scrap from processors participating in the National Vehicle Mercury Switch Recovery Program. Steelmakers will have three years to comply with the new mercury rule. PARTS is reviewing the EPA Mercury rule and hopes to meet with PA-ISRI to further discuss its impact on both our industries. PARTS continues to recommend that members enroll in the National Vehicle Mercury Switch Recovery Program which offers a \$1 per switch rebate along with free shipping.
