HB 1742 - METALS THEFT LEGISLATION PASSES HOUSE

House Bill 1742, Collection of Information by Scrap Processors & Recyclers, passed the Pennsylvania House of Representatives and now moves onto the Senate for consideration. The bill seeks to reduce theft of catalytic converters and other metals by requiring recyclers and scrap processors to record the following information when the purchase price of the scrap materials exceeds **\$50**:

- + Name, phone number and address of seller;
- + Seller's driver's license number or other form of government ID;
- + Make, year, type and license plate number of the seller's motor vehicle;
- + Creation of a unique identification number for the seller to be used each time a transaction is made with the seller; and,
- + The seller's signature for each transaction.

PARTS does not condone the theft taking place and continues to work with state and local law enforcement to help crack down on this illegal activity. While PARTS understands the purpose behind the bill, we do have some concerns with the current requirements contained in the legislation. Over the next few weeks, PARTS will be working with ISRI to communicate our concerns to state senators. We will keep members informed in the event your help is needed to contact your state senator.
