BEFORE MARCH 1, 2006

1. Request an official copy of your most recent academic transcripts from High School, College or Institution.
2. Submit the Active PARTS Membership Verification Form to your sponsoring PARTS Company.
3. If you are selected as a recipient, a wallet size photograph of yourself will be requested.
4. Complete and mail the enclosed Free Application for Federal Student Aid, **unless** completing the 2006-2007 Renewal FAFSA. (Addressed envelope enclosed)

5. Submit a copy of your 2005 Federal Tax Return. (If you are required to fill out your parent's information on the Free Application for Federal Student Aid, then you will need to submit a copy of their tax return also.)

2006-2007

PURPOSE

The Pennsylvania Automotive Recycling Trade Society (PARTS) Scholarship Foundation was established to memorialize the late members and honor some special current members of PARTS who contributed time, effort and monies to create a viable automotive recycling industry and association. The scholarships may be awarded to students who are graduates of high school. The awards will be made exclusively by the PARTS Scholarship Foundation.

CONDITIONS OF ELIGIBILITY

1. Applicants must be graduates of high school by June 30, 2006.
2. An applicant must enroll as a student at any accredited post high school institution during the academic year for which the scholarship is awarded. Freshman must submit a letter of acceptance.
3. An applicant must either be a child or stepchild of an owner who is an eligible Active PARTS member or an employee who has worked for an eligible PARTS member for at least one year prior to March 15 of award year, or a child/stepchild of such an employee.
4. An eligible* sponsoring Active PARTS member must complete, sign and submit a Verification Form. (***To be an eligible PARTS member, the company must be an Active PARTS member in good standing for at least one year prior to March 15 of the award year. An "Active" PARTS member is regularly engaged in the business of acquiring and dismantling abandoned or salvage vehicles for the purpose of selling usable parts and the remaining scrap materials... ASSOCIATE MEMBERS ARE NOT ELIGIBLE.**)
5. **BY MARCH 1, 2006**, the applicant must complete and mail the 2006-2007 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
6. An applicant must submit an official copy of a high school transcript or the latest post-secondary school grade transcript, whichever applies.

APPLICATION

Application forms shall be prepared and distributed by the Office of Financial Aid Services, Harrisburg Area Community College, One HACC Drive, Harrisburg, PA 17110. The completed application must be received by Student Financial Services by **April 1, 2006.**

SELECTION

Selection is based on a 100 point system of qualified applicants. The areas receiving points are: Personal/Academic Plans, Financial Need, Academics, and Activities. A maximum of five grants will be awarded annually. **Once an applicant has been selected for a grant, they are ineligible to reapply. Those not selected may reapply annually.**
